With what we are seeing tragically in Australian and American relationships splitting up, it's salutary to examine what still keeps men and women together in the first place apart from sex. Alternatively biological clocks are perceived as inevitably ticking time bombs, shattering lives and families aided and abetted by the matrimonial litigation conveyor belt. After 40 years marriage, "For Men Only" is the title of one of my upcoming books for both women and men and what sadly sometimes separates us. The book will be published or in manuscript notes for complimentary down-loading by attending seminar participants. While not strictly macho, major emphasis is in opposite directions from Germaine Greer and Hyte Report sociology approaches, contrastingly teaching men a range of gentle skills without "Rules" or evolving to snag or stud hybrids.

Is man and woman's greatest need, to love and be loved? Can we avoid the labyrinth of booby traps in volatile or vulnerable relationships already set along our path to happiness, with or without a magic pill for crushed nuts syndrome prophylaxis?

What damage did Spock, Kinsey or Masters & Johnson do in setting assumed norms. Mom told us to wash our hands and clean our nails. Was that sissy? What did Dad say? Has anyone published the lamentable connection with UTI's? The author's training in Marriage Guidance and sexuality ironically underscores his disappointment in what many clinicians have observed in effervescent pop psychology trash; missing basic points resulting in perennial medical problems year after year with patients. And so the presentation ebbs and flows with topics such as preventing enlarged prostate and cancer risk factors hopefully facilitating easy fast changes to an enjoyable wholesome up and at it lifestyle.
